NC: THE STATE OF THE ARTS CONFERENCE REGISTRATION FEES

Conference registration includes two continental breakfasts (Friday & Saturday mornings), two all-conference receptions (Thursday & Friday evenings) and one box lunch (Friday).

Early Bird Registration (October 13, 2008 - January 16, 2009)

Individual Early Bird Rate **\$105**

Organization Early Bird Team Rate (per person) **\$75**

(Team consists of a minimum of 3 to a maximum of 5 staff and/or board members from a single organization.)
Rate is per person. ALL registrations must be received together and paid with one credit card, check or purchase order.
Limit one team per organization.

School Early Bird Team Rate Team (per person) **\$75**

(Team consists of a minimum of 3 to a maximum of 5 educators, administrators and/or parents from a single school or school district.) Rate is per person. ALL registrations must be received together and paid with one credit card, check or purchase order. **Limit one team per school.**

Regular Registration (January 17 – February 27, 2009)

Individual Rate **\$140**

Organization Team Rate (per person) **\$100**

(Team consists of a minimum of 3 to a maximum of 5 staff and/or board members from a single organization.)
Rate is per person. ALL registrations must be received together and paid with one credit card, check or purchase order.

School Team Rate (per person) **\$100**

(Team consists of a minimum of 3 to a maximum of 5 educators, administrators and/or parents from a single school or school district.) Rate is per person. ALL registrations must be received together and paid with one credit card, check or purchase order.

Pre-Service Teacher Registration **\$25**

Single Day Registration (Friday only) **\$75**

(This includes a boxed lunch and a ticket to the Friday night reception.)

On-site Registration **\$175**

(This does not include the boxed lunch on Friday. Also, we cannot guarantee reception tickets—extras will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.)
