



2023-2024 ARTS FOR TOWNS: GRANT GUIDELINES

The non-competitive Arts for Towns grants support arts programming by North Carolina-based artists in municipalities across Wake County.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The Wake County municipal governments of Apex, Cary, Fuquay-Varina, Garner, Holly Springs, Knightdale, Morrisville, Rolesville, Wake Forest, Wendell, and Zebulon or their departments are eligible to apply. One application per town will be accepted.

GRANT REQUEST

Each eligible town may request up to \$5,000 to support eligible artist fees for arts programming to take place July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024, in its municipality.

ELIGIBLE ARTIST FEES

Grant funding may only be used to pay North Carolina-based artists or arts organizations, such as:

- Performing Artists: musicians, dancers, theatre companies, etc.
- Teaching Artists: to lead workshops, residencies, camps, etc.
- Visual Artists: to create murals, exhibit artwork, etc.

Equipment, marketing, staffing, and other costs are not eligible.

Friday May 26, 2023, by 5:00 p.m.

REVIEW PROCESS

Each grant application will be carefully reviewed by United Arts to determine eligibility. Allocations will be made based on eligible requests and available funding.
